Several staff positions are **REQUIRED** to have current certification for employment this summer. Please review the attached **Certification Requirement** outline to see whether or not you need to be certified. If you hold any kind of current certification (i.e., CPR, First Aid, Lifeguard Training, WSI, AHA/ASHA Riding Certification, Small craft, etc), we need copies of it **NOW**.

If you don't currently hold appropriate certification as outlined on attached sheet, **DON'T WORRY**. The American Red Cross offers Lifeguard Training, CPR and First Aid courses in most major cities and at many Universities. If you choose to take one of these courses in your area, please call us to discuss "tuition" reimbursement. If you're not able to take the course(s) locally or through your college, Kamaji offers the following courses before staff orientation. If you intend on attending one of the certification courses offered below, plan on arriving at camp the day before your course begins.

WILDERNESS FIRST AID TRAINING (June 3rd- 4th). This course is required for Wilderness Trip Leaders Only

LIFEGUARD TRAINING * (June 6th — June 9th)

* NOTE: The Lifeguard Training certification course includes the required First Aid/CPR classes so participants in Lifeguard Training do not have to sign up for the separate First Aid/CPR class offered below on June 9th — **however** staff whose lifeguard training certification predates September 2010 **must** take the June 9th **CPR for the Professional Rescuer** for their Lifeguard certification to remain valid.

CPR FOR THE PROFESSIONAL RESCUER RE-CERTIFICATION FOR LIFEGUARDS (June 9th)

This course is for those who are currently Lifeguard certified through, at least, August 2011. To maintain Lifeguard certification, you must take a yearly CPR course and this is the new mandatory American Red Cross course that you need to take.

CPR FOR THE PROFESSIONAL RESCUER (June 9th)

This course is for Nurses, Riding Instructors and Climbing Wall/Low Ropes Instructors.

FIRST AID (June 9th)

This course is JUST for non-lifeguards such as Nurses, Riding Instructors and Climbing Wall/Low Ropes Instructors

NOTE: ROOM AND BOARD, PLUS COST OF CLINIC, WILL BE PROVIDED SHOULD YOU ATTEND THE CLINICS LISTED ABOVE.
