

CAMP KAMAJI LAKE SUPERIOR CLIMBING TRIPS — 2011

This summer Camp Kamaji will again be offering three-day **ROCK CLIMBING TRIPS** to Minnesota's North Shore of Lake Superior. There will be two trips each for both first and second sessions. All climbing activities will be under the supervision of certified instructors from the University of Minnesota-Duluth Recreational Sports Outdoor Program.

Following is the three-day Rock Climbing Trip Itinerary:

- Day 1** — On the University of Minnesota - Duluth Campus
A two-hour introduction to climbing on the UM-D Inland Climbing Wall will give campers a review of knots, climbing techniques and safety systems.

Overnight camping at Tettegouche State Park.
- Day 2** — Climbing at Temperance River State Park
Campers will hike to beautiful inland dome of rock and spend the morning and early afternoon climbing. Then campers will hike to Lake Superior shore and practice rappelling.

Overnight camping at Tettegouche State Park.
- Day 3** — Climbing at Tettegouche State Park
Campers will rappel and climb the cliffs above Lake Superior and return to camp later that evening.

Eight campers will be chosen for each trip on the basis of climbing ability, attitude and interest. Only campers whose parents complete both sides of this form will be considered for the trip. The cost of the trip (\$200⁰⁰ per camper) will be passed on to the parents of the participants. Parents will be billed following the trip.

If you would like your daughter to be considered for the Lake Superior Climbing Trip, please complete both sides of this registration form and return it to Camp Kamaji before June 1, 2011.

Please understand that completing this form means that your daughter will be considered for the climbing trip **but** it does not guarantee her selection. If you have any questions about the trip, don't hesitate to contact us.
