

CAMP KAMAJI FOR GIRLS – PERSONAL PROPERTY REGULATIONS

Campers and staff are requested to abide by the following regulations with regard to personal property and pets:

CAMERAS/VIDEO EQUIPMENT Campers and staff will be required to accept personal responsibility for camera and video equipment brought to camp. Since Kamaji does not have a way to safely store electronic equipment, we ask those staff members who choose to bring this type of equipment to camp to take full responsibility for it. Kamaji strongly suggests that such equipment be covered on individual homeowner policies or by a floater insurance policy. It is impossible for Kamaji to obtain insurance coverage for personal items.

SPORTING GOODS EQUIPMENT Archery, tennis and/or fishing equipment brought to camp by campers and staff will be stored at the activity area under lock and key. Only the owner of such equipment will be allowed to use it; and then only under the supervision of the activity specialist. Kamaji strongly suggests that such equipment be covered on individual homeowner policies or by a floater insurance policy as Kamaji is unable to obtain insurance coverage for personal items.

No riflery equipment (rifle/gun, ammunition) or sheathed knives (for fishing) or pocket knives will be allowed at camp.

AQUATIC EQUIPMENT Campers are not permitted to bring waterskis, sailboats, sailboards, kayaks, etc. to camp for their personal use. Staff may bring aquatic equipment to camp however such equipment must be stored at the waterfront and used only when authorized by the Waterfront Director and under the supervision of the appropriate activity specialist. Anyone who chooses to bring aquatic equipment to camp must take full responsibility for it. It is strongly suggested that such equipment be insured under individual homeowner policies or by a floater insurance policy as Kamaji is unable to obtain insurance coverage for personal items.

MUSICAL EQUIPMENT We neither encourage nor discourage campers and staff from bringing musical equipment to camp. However, since we do not have a way to safely store musical equipment, we ask anyone who chooses to bring a musical instrument to camp to take full responsibility for it. It is strongly suggested that any musical instrument brought to camp be insured under individual homeowner policies or by a floater insurance policy as Kamaji is unable to obtain insurance coverage for personal items.

DISCMAN/I-PODS, MINI-DISC PLAYERS, BLACKBERRIES, COMPUTERS, PAGERS, GAMEBOYS, PCPS, ETC. Campers, under no circumstance, are allowed to have DISCMAN, Blackberries, pagers, mini-disc players, computers, GameBoys, PCPs, I-Pods, or other hand-held games at camp. Such items **will be confiscated and returned home with shipping costs charged to Camper's Store Account.**

Staff are strongly discouraged from bringing electronic equipment to camp. Since Kamaji does not have a way to safely store electronic equipment, we ask those staff members who choose to bring this type of equipment to camp to take full responsibility for it. It is strongly suggested that any electronic equipment brought to camp be insured under individual homeowner policies or by a floater insurance policy as Kamaji is unable to obtain insurance coverage for personal items.

Staff are prohibited from using any such electronic equipment in camper cabins, camper activity areas and/or anywhere in camp that is within earshot or eyeshot of campers. Staff are also prohibited from allowing any camper to use electronic equipment of any kind. Use of such equipment by staff is limited to designated free time and within the confines of the staff lounge rooms.

CELL PHONES

Campers may not bring cell phones to camp. Any brought to camp will be **will be confiscated and returned home with shipping costs charged to Camper's Store Account.**

Staff (including CITs) may have cell phones for personal use on time-off only. Since Kamaji does not have a way to safely store cell phones, we ask those staff members who choose to bring one to assume full responsibility for safe keeping of their own cell phone. It is strongly suggested that cell phones be insured under individual homeowner policies or by a floater insurance policy as Kamaji is unable to obtain insurance coverage for personal items.

Staff are prohibited from using cell phones in camper cabins, camper activity areas and/or anywhere in camp that is within earshot or eyeshot of campers. Staff are also prohibited from allowing any camper to use staff cell phones. Use of such equipment by staff is limited to designated free time and within the confines of the staff lounge rooms.

PETS

Campers and staff (as well as their guests) are not permitted to bring pets to camp.

AUTOMOBILES

- * Counselors-in-Training (CITs) and campers are not allowed to have vehicles at camp.
- * Private automobiles in camp are subject to camp regulations. Private cars may not be used in camp. Park cars in designated area only.
- * Bring your driver's license.
- * Be informed on the insurance hazards and regulations.
- * Camp Kamaji cannot assume any responsibility for a staff member's vehicle or possessions in the vehicle.
- * We would ask those staff members who choose to bring a car to assume full responsibility for its safekeeping and any contents/possessions within the vehicle. It is strongly suggested that you review your automobile insurance policy to cover both your vehicle and any contents within as Kamaji is unable to obtain insurance coverage for privately owned vehicles.
- * With your signed permission, cars will be considered stand-by camp transportation in case of emergency only. In this situation only, would a privately owned staff vehicle be covered under Camp Kamaji's insurance policy.
- * Borrowing cars from other counselors results in bad feelings. It is up to the discretion of the staff member whether or not he/she chooses to lend his/her car. Our suggestion is neither to ask to borrow or to lend.
- * **To rent car or to sell passage in one's car is not permitted.**
